Outdoor Pickleball Courts Opening Soon for SSFA



The City of Saskatoon has given us a tentative start date for outdoor play at Father Basil Markle Courts for Monday, May 9th (Weather permitting). The courts may be open earlier for public play

depending on the City's schedule. The following time slots for SSFA play at Father Basil Markle Courts beginning Monday May 9th are:

Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays

1:00p.m. – 4:00p.m.

Tuesdays & Thursdays

10:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon



Please note: For outdoor play, SSFA does not supply equipment when temperatures are under 10 degrees Celsius so bring your own balls!

Covid Provincial Health Regulations are in effect. There are no vaccine requirements or mask mandates in effect for outdoor pickleball play. Please feel free to wear a mask for your own health and safety. Hand Sanitizer will be provided. It is up to everyone to look after their own safety.

Remember, be kind to your fellow pickleball players and respect each others' decisions.
